FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full Membership of the Civil Service Sailing Association is open to anyone eligible for membership of the Civil Service Sports Council (Sports and Leisure). In addition to employees of the Civil Service, BT and the Post Office, this includes the staff of over one hundred other bodies such as the Civil Aviation Authority, English Heritage and the Research Councils, and members of HM armed forces serving in HM civil establishments. Local Authority and National Health employees are excluded. Full Membership is also open to former members of CSSC who have left government service, or those who have retired and are still receiving a pension from an eligible organisation. If in doubt about your eligibility, please contact the CSSA Membership Sec. Ken Pavitt 02392 529729, or the CSSC Membership Dept. 01494 888418.

If you are already paying for CSSC Membership Plus and can quote your CSSC membership number, simply complete and return the form overleaf for Full Membership of the CSSA and you will receive your card with no further charge. Otherwise please complete and return an application for CSSC Sports and Leisure - Membership Plus, together with the form overleaf. For 2006 CSSC Membership Plus is £5.50 per month, or £66.00 per annum. All of the facilities and events of the CSSA are developed, run and maintained by volunteers, so many of the amateur and professional skills of its members are very welcome. Please mention any such skills, knowledge or experience on the form overleaf where shown.

The CSSA has several constituent Clubs and Divisions around the country for dinghy and yacht sailing, as described in separate leaflets. CSSA members are eligible to join these clubs but may have to pay an additional annual subscription to the Club or Division for use of local facilities. The CSSA operates three yachts for its members, all with a crewing bureau. Please indicate your clubs of interest overleaf. On return of this form you are a member of CSSA and should receive a membership card and start receiving "CS Sailing" magazine, subject to confirmation of your Membership Plus by CSSC.

E ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

If you are not eligible for membership of the Civil Service Sports Council, you may still apply for membership of CSSA as an Associate Member. Your application must be proposed and seconded by two existing Full Members of CSSA, supported by an Officer of one of the Clubs or Divisions, and approved by the appropriate Committee of that Club or Division, as only limited numbers of Associate Members are allowed (10% of membership of each Club/Division). Potential Associate Members can first use a trial
